### Disaster Volunteering This Winter

OLYMPIA- September is Emergency Preparedness Month and those preparations include getting ready to volunteer during a disaster. The Volunteer Center of Lewis, Mason and Thurston Counties works with dozens of nonprofit and public agencies that respond during and after a disaster in the three counties we serve. And most of those organizations agree that knowing how to help ahead of time is the key to a quick and effective volunteer response.

To volunteer wisely in times of disaster, follow these guidelines:

1. GET TRAINED-Most disaster organizations require a level of training to be sure their volunteers are qualified to supply the services the clients need. Though it is sometimes possible to train you in the moment, it is not the most effective way. Signing up with a disaster-based organization before a disaster is the BEST way to be a great volunteer later.
2. VOLUNTEER LOCALLY-Your community is great place to start. There are hundreds of organizations that provide direct social service support in your area and many of these have disaster components to prepare and support those in your area. These same volunteers are often the first line of support in other areas when disaster strikes. Fortunately, community members won't have difficulty finding those opportunities. **On Sept. 11** the Volunteer Center offers one-on-one volunteer matching from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., at the Capitol Campus Safety Fair off of Capitol Boulevard across the street from the Tivoli Fountain on the Capitol Campus.
3. GIVE CASH-Financial gifts get help to people fast. Financial contributions are best, because they allow relief organizations to address specific needs most

relief organizations to address specific needs most quickly. Make sure the organization you are giving to is legitimate by visiting [guidestar.com](http://guidestar.com). If you plan on collecting items, ASK as many items may not be needed and may be difficult for organizations to store.

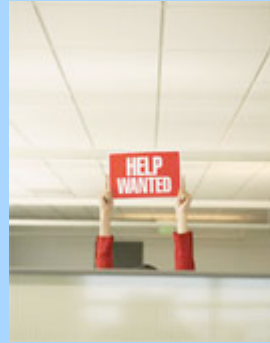
